! **Think** before you act!

- Act responsibly towards yourself and others whether online or offline.

! **Think** before you say things that will hurt others online!

- Everyone has a right to be respected. Respect others just as you wish to be respected.
- Respect the Law – Cyber bullying is a crime.

! **Think** before you post online!

- Once you post something online it can last forever as it can be saved and shared by others.
- Your digital footprint is made up of information found about you online. People may form their opinion about you depending on your digital footprint.

! **Think** before you share online!

- Do not share anything which might get you or your friends into trouble today or which you might regret in the future.
- Be careful of what you share with friends online. Remember that today's friends will not necessarily be friends tomorrow.

! **Think** before you give in to peer pressure!

- Refuse requests that make you feel uncomfortable.

! **Think** before using information you find online!

- Make sure that the websites you are using are trustworthy.
